Aim to eat fruit and vegetables everyday - the greater the variety, the better health benefits.

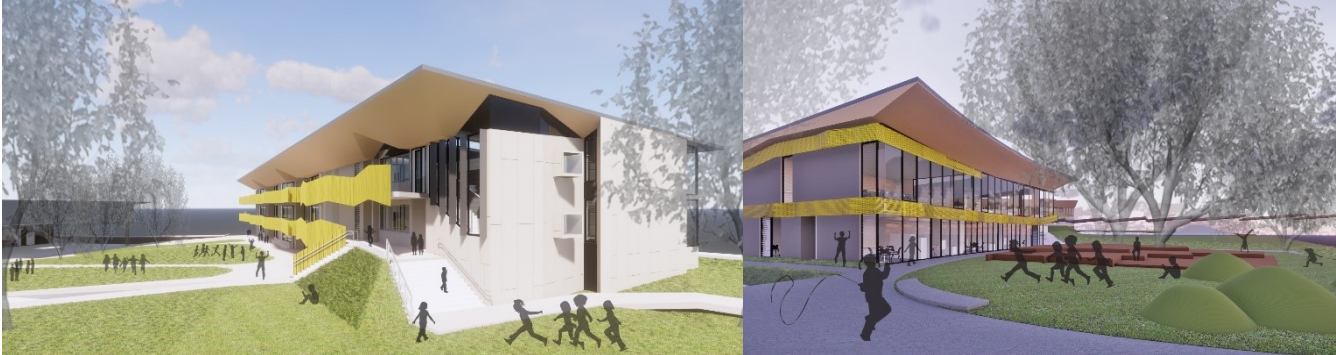
