Canterbury South Public School raised \$637 through a combination of online and gold coin donations. Thank you to our SRC and community for supporting this initiative!

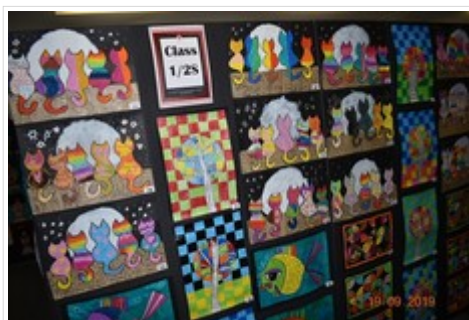
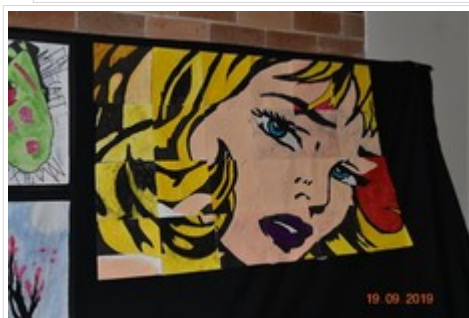


Judo Junior School Cup
