In recent news, there has been much talk about the effectiveness of Explicit Instruction in Literacy.

At Canterbury South Public School, we've embraced this approach since 2022, and we're thrilled to share the positive impact it's having on our students' reading skills. We embrace the science of reading—an evidence based, neuroscience driven approach that ensures reading is taught systematically and comprehensively. This year, we've already begun to closely monitor your child's progress through individual assessments that focus on decoding, accuracy, fluency, and comprehension.

We prioritise every child's reading journey, ensuring they have the tools for success from the very beginning. That's why we conduct a mandatory Year 1 screening check to identify any areas where our students may need extra support. Early interventions are then implemented to ensure no child falls behind and on occasions, we will seek your support in accessing services to enable this.

We understand the crucial role parents play in supporting their child's literacy development. Here are some simple ways you can help at home:

- 1. Set aside dedicated time for reading together each day.
- 2. Encourage your child to practice reading aloud, and praise their efforts.
- 3. Provide a variety of reading materials to spark their interest.
- 4. Ask questions about the story to enhance comprehension and critical thinking skills.

We're excited to discuss your child's reading journey with you during the upcoming 3-way conferences in Week 11. Together we can continue to nurture our young readers and empower

them with the gift of literacy.






Updating Absences
